New Wave Football Photo & Video Release Consent Policy

New Wave Football (the "Business") respects the privacy of its players and their families. This Photo and Video Release Consent Policy (the "Policy") outlines how the Business obtains consent to use photographs and video recordings of players participating in the Business's programs (the "Images").

By registering a player for a program offered by the Business, the player's parent or legal guardian (the "Guardian") agrees to the terms of this Policy.

The Business may use Images of players for the following purposes:

- On the Business's website and social media platforms to promote the Business's programs and activities.
- In Business newsletters and marketing materials.

The Business will not use images of any player in a way that is disrespectful, discriminatory, or otherwise harmful.

The Guardian grants the Business a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license to use the images for the purposes described above. This license will continue indefinitely unless revoked by the Guardian in writing.

The Guardian has the right to revoke consent at any time by submitting a written request to the Business. The Business will make reasonable efforts to remove the Images from its website and social media platforms within

a commercially reasonable time after receiving a written revocation of consent. However, the Business may not be able to remove Images from all materials where they have already been distributed.

The Business is committed to protecting the privacy of children. In some cases, the Business may obtain a separate consent form from a player who is 18 years of age or older.
